## Spring Sports Sign Ups

### Soccer (Boys and Girls)

Kilgour plays in the Cincinnati East SAY soccer league. The soccer registration period for the upcoming spring season begins on January 8 for 3 weeks and ends on February 1. Spring soccer sign-ups are held in January to meet SAY league deadlines in February for player and team registrations. Team formation and player draw occurs immediately after the registration deadline, based on registered players at that time. **Parents must register their child on or before the February 1 registration deadline to ensure your player will be placed on a Kilgour team.** Additional information, Registration Forms, and FAQs are available on the "soccer" web page of the KSB website.

**Registration Deadline:** On-Time Registration for Spring Soccer ends February 1, which is the deadline to guarantee playing on a Kilgour team. Late Registration begins February 2 and players will be placed on a waiting list, pending available space on a team. Soccer coordinators will do their best to place players on Kilgour teams, but there is no guarantee if registration is late.

**Registration Fees:** On-Time Registration Fee is \$30 per child. Late Registration Fee is \$40 per child. Checks are payable to *Kilgour Sports Boosters*. Payment is required with submission of registration form to the KSB mailbox.

**Registration forms:** Parents must complete and sign a registration form, which is available in the Kilgour lobby, or online at [www.kilgoursports.org](http://www.kilgoursports.org).

**Eligibility:** SAY soccer divisions are based on a player's AGE, not their grade (see website for details).

**Kindergarteners:** This is the 1<sup>st</sup> season most Kindergarteners (age 6-7) are eligible to play SAY soccer.

**Sixth Graders:** Players age 12-13 wishing to play SAY soccer this spring should register at this time, but not pay a player fee. Kilgour coordinates the placement of players and fees with area schools (i.e. Walnut Hills).

**Coaches:** Kilgour needs head coaches and assistants; especially in the Passers and Strikers age divisions. Soccer experience is not necessary. KSB pays for an excellent SAY coaching clinic. Please mark your registration form if you wish to coach and contact Jim Harmann soon.

### Softball (Girls)

Kilgour girls grades K-2 and 3-4 may play slowpitch softball in the spring with the Fairfax Youth Softball League. Girls grades 5-6 will be playing fastpitch through Southwest Ohio Girls FastPitch Softball Assoc. ([www.sogfsa.org](http://www.sogfsa.org)).

**Player fees:** \$25 per player for girls K-4 and \$65 for girls 5-6. Checks are payable to *Kilgour Sports Boosters*.

**Eligibility:** Teams are based officially on a player's AGE, not their grade (see website for details).

**Coaches:** Kilgour needs head coaches and assistants. Please note on sign-up sheet your interest to coach.
